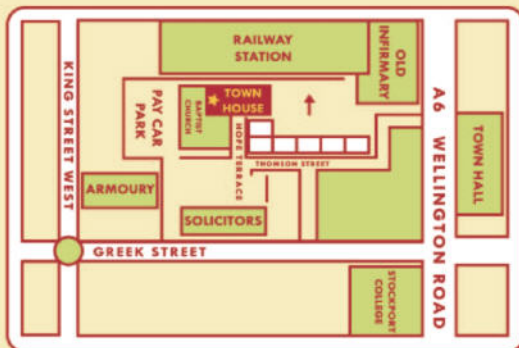

## Who are we?

SCC was set up in 1991 by a group from local Churches.

We offer counselling services to all people 16 years of age or over who feel in need of help when life's difficulties make it hard to cope.

We are a registered charity and are staffed entirely by unwaged: trained counsellors; professional supervisors; administrative staff; receptionists and a management committee.

Our counsellors are men and women who have trained and studied to obtain recognised counselling qualifications.

Confidentiality is an essential part of the counselling process.

We also offer training and support to groups on counselling-related issues. SCC abides by the B.A.C.P. & A.C.C. Code of ethics.

## What services do we offer?

If anyone is unsure if counselling is for them, they can call in at 'Hear & Now' Drop-in Centre at the Town House, We are open every Monday from 1-3p.m. (except Bank Holidays), and people there will be ready to listen to you. No appointment is necessary. More formal counselling sessions are available by appointment. For these you will be linked with a counsellor, meetings are regularly arranged at a mutually convenient time.

## How much will it cost?

SCC Services are funded from donations and contributions. This enables the work to continue and to be open to all, regardless of the ability to pay.

Clients are invited to make a contribution towards the cost of the counselling they receive. The counsellor will discuss this at the first session.
